

## Peculiarities of Version 3.1.0.11 and above for NADAC

Due to the type of changes made

**DATABASES CREATED IN A PREVIOUS VERSION OF AU**  
*(pre version 11)*

**CANNOT BE OPENED IN VERSION 3.1.0.11 OR ABOVE**

### FAQ 1

**I have started a trial with a version earlier than version 3.1.0.11 and want to take advantage of the new NADAC rules.**

- Veteran dogs and Junior Handlers in all classes,
- 20+ has been removed and
- all dogs over 18" are part of the 20" grouping.
- Clubs can group Skilled and Proficient for placings or separate them. At NADAC fun-raisers and champs, we combine them.
- Longer times for all dogs in Jumpers, Touch N Go and Weavers.
- New SCT table in Version 3.1.0.14

**BEFORE** installing version 3.1.0.11 or above

1. Export your last trial database or the one that you plan to “restart” to the Master Database
  - a. Go to Cleanup
  - b. click on Export to Master Database
  - c. follow the directions
2. Download the latest version from the “Download” button on the Agility Unscrambled website Existing customer page and Install it.
3. Open Agility Unscrambled and Start a New Trial. When asked about importing trial info direct AU to the database you are replacing or any other database with pertinent info to be used.
4. Complete Trial setup
5. Go to Add / Edit Entries and when prompted – direct AU to your Master Database

You are off and running!

## FAQ 2

### **I want to start a new trial and want to use the latest version then**

**BEFORE** installing the latest version

1. Export your last trial database to the Master Database
  - a. Go to Cleanup
  - b. click on Export to Master Database
  - c. follow the directions
2. Download the latest version from the “Download” button on the Agility Unscrambled website Existing customer page and Install it.
3. Open Agility Unscrambled and Start a New Trial. When asked about importing trial info direct AU to any trial database with pertinent for this trial
4. Complete Trial setup
5. Go to Add / Edit Entries and when prompted – direct AU to your Master Database

You are off and running!

## FAQ 3

### **I have the latest version (3.1.0.11 or above) and need to open a database created with an old version.**

Unfortunately a side effect of the significant changes to version 3.1.0.11 and above, you can no longer open older databases. To work around this issue

1. Go to the website Existing Customer page and look in the box where the Download Button is. Look down to the words Version 3.1.0.9. Click there to download the last version that will open old databases.
2. Uninstall the version of AU on your computer (3.1.0.11 or above)
3. Install version 3.1.0.9.
  - a. Open your old database
4. When you are finished. Download the latest version from the “Download” button on the Agility Unscrambled website Existing customer page and Install it so you are ready for your next trial.
